Driver's License Physical Exam

You will need to schedule a medical exam with the Health and Wellness Center on campus. The doctor needs to complete the back side of the <u>Learner's Permit application</u>. This must be completed before you can go to the DMV to apply for a license.

Read the PA Driver's Manual on the DMV's website - www.dmv.pa.gov under "Driver Services - Driver Licensing." To help you prepare for the knowledge test, you can get an app called PA Driver's Practice Test, which is free on iOS or Google Play.

Applying for a Learner's Permit at the DMV

Documents to Take to the DMV When You Apply

- 1. <u>Learner's permit application form</u> completed with medical exam portion filled out by medical doctor at Health and Wellness Center
- 2. Passport/Visa
- 3. I-20
- 4. I-94 print form online at i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94/#/home
- 5. Social security card **OR** rejection letter from Social Security Office
- 6. PSU Student ID Card
- 7. 2 proofs of address bill, bank statement, lease, etc. showing your name and address in Erie
- 8. Check or money order for \$35.50

Must complete and pass your knowledge test and vision test at the DMV in order to receive a learner's permit. Once you have your permit, you will be able to schedule your driving exam right away in the DMV office, or call the DMV later at 1-800-423-5542 to schedule. If you take your driving exam at the DMV, you will need to come with a PA licensed driver who is 21 years or older and bring a car that you can use for your driving exam. *See section below for another option for taking the driving exam.*

If you want to purchase a car in Pennsylvania – You will need to have a Pennsylvania Driver's license or Photo ID in order to get your car titled and registered.
