In addition to providing financial support through the Student Hardship Fund for food and housing, he received guidance to secure a summer job and even household items donated by concerned Penn State Behrend employees. All of this kept him from having to live on the streets. Thanks to the Student Hardship Fund, which is fully funded by employee donations, this student is continuing to pursue his degree at Behrend and maintains a 3.74 GPA.*
